Washing & Care

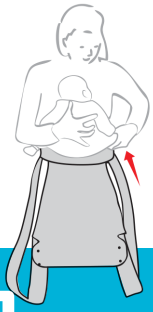

Fit belt tightly around waist. Allow the carrier's body to hang down in front of you. Place baby on your chest.

Pull up the carrier between the baby's legs. Secure the baby with one hand and put one shoulder strap over your shoulder.



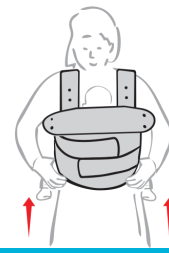

Switch hands. Reach for the shoulder strap. Pull it diagonally across your back and attach it firmly to the body of the carrier.

Repeat with the second shoulder strap. Now the straps should be crossed behind your back, but not crossed in the front velcro area.

Adjust straps. Make sure the carrier doesn't tilt to one side. Baby should sit in an M position, knees bent and level with belly button.

Very young or sleeping children without proper head control should be supported with the snap fastened head protection.

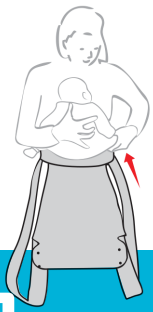
MICRO-VELCRO MUST BE clean and straps should reach past each other at least 5 inches when secured.

NEVER OPEN WAIST BELT with a baby in the carrier. To adjust belt, first secure baby with your hands.

MAINTEIN HAND CONTACT and support for your baby AT ALL TIMES while securing or adjusting straps.

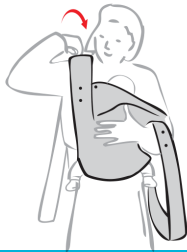

Pull up the carrier between the baby's legs. Secure the baby with one hand and put one shoulder strap over your shoulder.



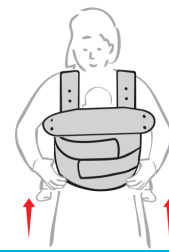

Switch hands. Reach for the shoulder strap. Pull it diagonally across your back and attach it firmly to the body of the carrier.

MICRO-VELCRO MUST BE clean and straps should reach past each other at least 5 inches when secured.

NEVER OPEN WAIST BELT with a baby in the carrier. To adjust belt, first secure baby with your hands.

MAINTEIN HAND CONTACT and support for your baby AT ALL TIMES while securing or adjusting straps.
